



Visitor Parking

Visitor parking on the Mānoa Campus is available in the green color Pay-to-Park visitor stalls located in parking lots mauka of Dole Street and in the Lower Campus and Dole Street Parking Structures.

Upper Campus – Pay-to-Park Green Stalls

- Automated Pay Stations
 - Located in designated parking lots.
 - 2.00 per half hour up to a maximum of \$16.00
 - Accepts quarters, dollar coins, \$1, \$5, and \$10 bills
 - Issues a permit ticket that must be displayed on dashboard of vehicle showing the time until which the visitor has paid.
- Daily Visitor permit
 - \$16.00 fee from automated Pay Station
 - Allows re-entry into the Upper Campus visitor lots all day
- After 4PM & Weekends
 - Flat fee collection of \$3.00 upon entry.
 - Parking allowed in all regular parking stalls during these periods.

Lower Campus – Parking Structure

- Parking Structures
 - Lower Campus Parking Structure (Zone 20)
 - Flat rate fee of \$3.00 payable upon entry at kiosks
 - Hours are from 5:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.
- Reentry
 - Lower Campus Parking Structure (Zone 20)
 - Allowed after 1:30 p.m with a paid daily permit
 - With daily visitor permit, allowed after 4:00 p.m.
 - Must stop to show the attendant permit when re-entering.

Parking Services reserves the right to close parking areas, restrict entry to certain areas and/or designate alternative parking based on special events and/or circumstances.
